

## KIMBER'S UPDATE – OCTOBER 2024



This is my third attempt at writing to you. For various reasons, I start, but don't finish. We are still very busy with the installation of the replacement transmitter in West Central Asia. Since my last update I've made two visits and one aborted visit. We thank the Lord that the installation phase is now complete and we've started testing. In the picture you can see the transmitter consisting of two rows of equipment racks. The cooling system is behind me and the power supply in an adjacent room. I'm due to return to Central Asia this weekend for a further 10 days of testing. Please pray for safety and wisdom while we work. Pray that we'll complete the testing during this visit. We look forward to the day when this equipment will be broadcasting the Gospel to South Russia, Ukraine, Iran, Iraq & Syria.



You might be wondering why I had an aborted visit in July. On my way to Central Asia I had two flight cancellations plus a further 14 hour flight delay. I spent 2 nights in a hotel in Munich plus another night in Frankfurt. The airline also lost my baggage. If I continued with my journey I'd only have 1 working day in Central Asia, so we decided I should return home. My suitcase finally turned up in Central Asia after 12 days.
