I've recently returned from one of our Central Asia transmitter sites. Give thanks for safe journeys, and for easy passages through airport customs while carrying tools and spare parts. During the day we carried out repairs and maintenance on the transmitters. In the evening the same transmitters were used to broadcast Christian programmes into neighbouring countries. We sometimes stayed for the first part of the evening's transmissions to make sure the equipment was functioning well.

Some of those evening broadcasts were directed into India. A listener from India sent us this encouraging message: (the picture is not the listener or his family)

"I came from a different religious background. My parents were very devout followers. They worked in agriculture and they sent us to school. My family had a lot of issues and life was full of darkness.
